BIOBLITZ TRIP - Friday 23rd June

As part of the festival of Nature run by the Bristol Natural History Museum, Class Three and Class Four have an exciting trip arranged where they will get the opportunity to practise their Biology Skills.

Children will work in small groups and be part of a team, identifying, cataloguing and analysing the fauna in the area. This ties in beautifully with Class Three's Science Topic on 'Plants' and Class Four's Science Topic on 'Habitats'. The children will be working with experts from the Natural History Museum.

The activity will be based at Bushey Norwood close to Bath University on Friday 23rd June. We will depart from Bathampton at 11:40am. Activities will start at 12:15pm. The children will arrive back at school at approximately 3:00pm.

The children will need:-
