Class Three Trip to Avebury
Tuesday 28th March 2017

Dear Parents

Class Three have been studying the Stone Age. To support our topic work I have arranged a visit to the World Heritage Site of Avebury in Wiltshire on **Tuesday 28th March**. Avebury has the world's largest prehistoric stone circle, which was excavated by millionaire archaeologist Alexander Keiller in the 1930s.

During the visit the children will have an introductory talk by National Trust staff; they will also take part in a henge tour. They will visit the Alexander Keiller Museum, which displays archaeological treasures from across the World Heritage Site.

The coach will leave school at 9.15 am and return to school at 3.15pm.

Children need to wear school uniform and sensible footwear (walking boots or trainers). We will be outside most of the day so children will need suitable clothing for the weather.

The children will also need to bring a packed lunch and drink, no glass bottles. Packed lunches will be left in the education room at Avebury to avoid being carried all day.

We ask for a contribution of £11.00 towards the cost of the coach and for the henge tour.
