

Class Two Topic Web – Term 1

MATHS

Read and write numbers to 100 in numerals and words.
Recognise the place value of each digit in a 2-digit number (tens, ones).
Compare and order 2-digit numbers using < and > signs.
Find 1 or 10 more or less using a 100 square.
Find 10 more and 10 less than any 2-digit number.
Count in steps of 2, 5 and 10.
Revise number bonds to 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10.
Recall addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently.
Add and subtract 1-digit numbers to/from 2-digit numbers.
Add and subtract numbers to 100.
Use inverse relationships between addition and subtraction to solve missing number problems.
Know common 2D and 3D shapes.
Recognise lines of symmetry.
Sort 2D shapes into Venn diagrams using properties.
Begin to recognise right angles in shapes.

Discuss real life heroes – what makes someone a hero?
Understand why Florence Nightingale is a significant individual in history.

SCIENCE

Explore and compare differences between living and non-living things.
Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals for survival.
Label parts of the body and begin to think about what humans need to stay healthy.
