MATHS

Multiplication and division

Count in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10.
Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
Use the signs for multiplication (x), division (÷) and equals (=).

Shape

Identify and describe the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Find lines of symmetry in 2D shapes.

Identify 2D shapes as faces of 3D shapes.

Statistics

Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables.
Answer questions about totalling and comparing data.

Fractions

Recognise, name and write fractions of a shape.

Recognise the equivalence of $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{2}{4}$.

Find fractions of amounts.

Measurement

Estimate, measure and compare length and height (m/cm).

Use rulers accurately.

To understand the different ways that plants disperse their seeds.
