## Sports Premium 2017–2018

The government is providing additional funding to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools.

Bathampton Primary School, Bath, will be receiving £18,800 (including an underspend from the previous year)

The funding this year will be spent on the following:

- Funding an experienced School Sports partnership organiser to facilitate cluster sports events, provide training for teachers, identify Gifted and Talented children and offer specialist advice and opportunities for children and staff
- The employment of sports coaches from Premier Sports, or other agencies, to teach each class in the school. This enables the children to receive expert tuition and provides professional development and training for staff.
- Subsidising after school or lunch time sports clubs to allow more children to become involved in extra-curricular activities
- Transporting children to sporting activities in school time, particularly to participate in inter-school competition (e.g. bus and staff to take teams to cluster competitions)
- Updating resources as and where deemed necessary to provide quality PE lessons to the children

The impact of this funding will be measured through:

- pupil perception questionnaires measuring the interest of children in different areas of the PE curriculum
- staff questionnaires measuring their confidence in teaching PE
- the increase in the number of children engaging in inter school sporting activities
- the number of children attending a sports club either in school or outside
- the possible achievement of relevant awards, such as the School Games Mark
